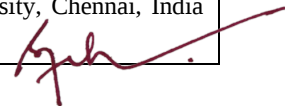

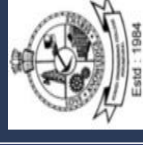

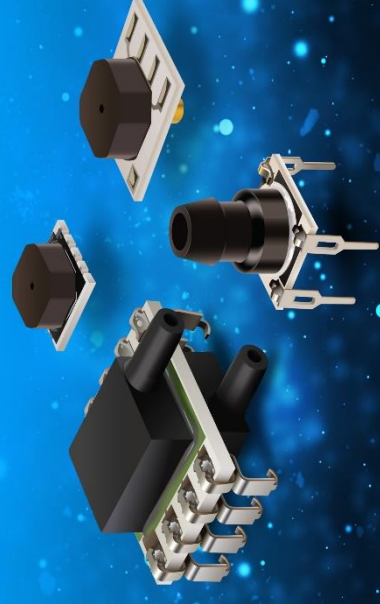

The introduction of Industry 4.0 gives rise to what is called “Smart Factory”. With IoT, different systems can communicate with each other, allowing cooperation with other human systems and operators in real-time. Machine learning in Industry 4.0 allows the existing patterns in the data to be extracted. These data sets can be used later to train machine learning algorithms with which it can predict the occurrence of incorrect operation or failures in the different individual components present in industries. 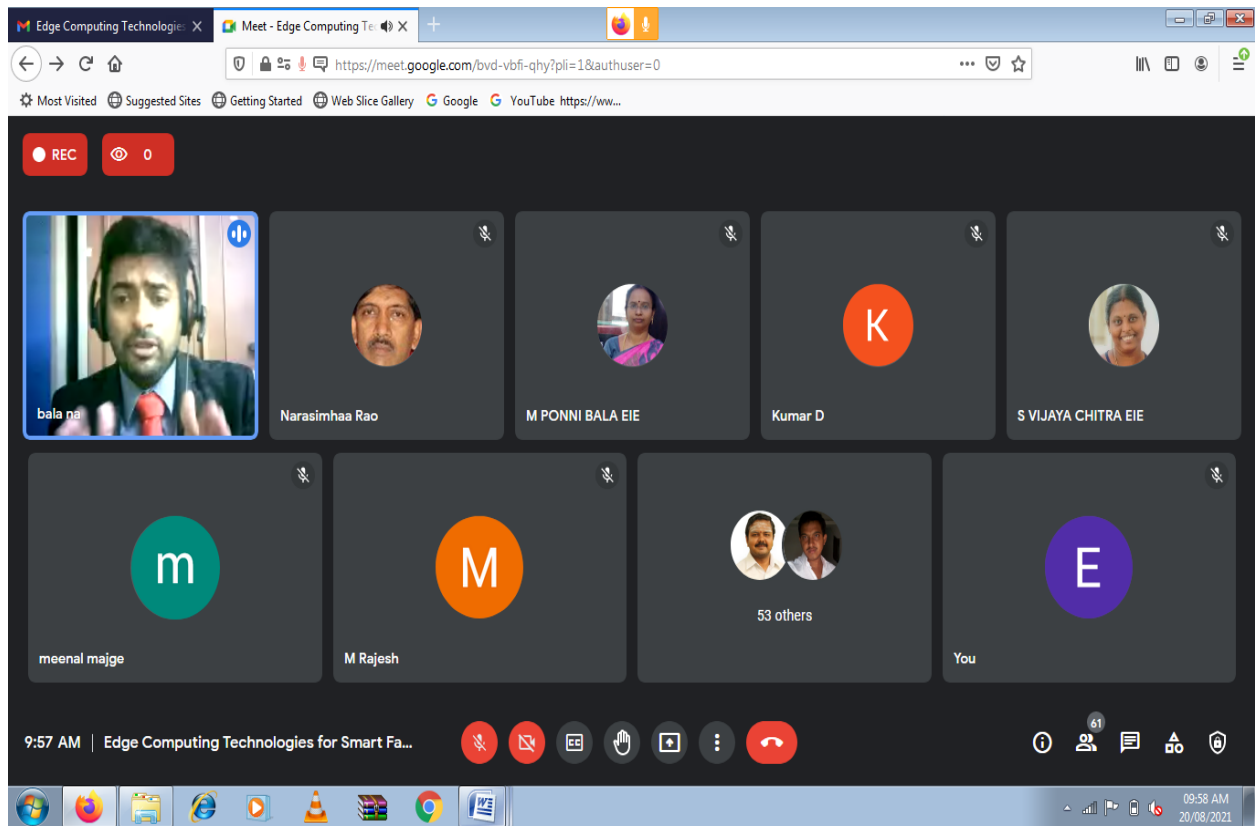
